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MR. HUGHES: The time is 1 o'clock. This 3 4

meeting is being conducted in person and is being held in the main hearing room of the William Green Building, located at 30 West Spring Street in Columbus, Ohio. The meeting is also being streamed on the Ohio Industrial Commission's YouTube channel. The link to listen to this meeting is available on the Industrial Commission's public website.

The purpose of this special meeting is limited to the following: Meeting called to order, roll call, meeting minute approval, review, discuss, and vote on five-year review of Ohio Administrative Code sections 4121-2-01; 4121-2-02; 4121-3-12; 4121-15-01; 4121-15-02; 4121-15-03; 4121-15-04; 4121-15-05; 4121-15-06; 4121-15-07; 4121-15-08; and 4121-15-09.

During this meeting -- and also part of the meeting is also the adjournment -- during this meeting it is important that prior to speaking the first time, each participant introduce themselves by saying their name and title. MR. ADAMS: This is Tim Adams, Executive Director of the Ohio Industrial Commission. As I call your name, please restate your name and affirm your presence. Commissioner Hottinger?

MS. HOTTINGER: Cheri Hottinger, present.

MR. ADAMS: Commissioner Massey?

MR. MASSEY: Dan Massey, here.

MR. ADAMS: Chairman Hughes?

MR. HUGHES: Chairman Hughes, here.

We will now move to the review and discussion of the special meeting minutes of August 8th, 2023. Do we have any discussion on those minutes?

Hearing none, I move to adopt the minutes for the special meeting held August 8th, 2023, as written.

Motion does carry, we'll now move to the review and discussion of 2024 five-year rule for review.

I will now ask our Deputy Chief Legal Counsel,

Amanda Brown, to provide a brief summary of the recommendations for the 12 rules that are currently scheduled for five-year rule review.

MS. BROWN: Thank you, Chairman Hughes --

MR. HUGHES: Ms. Brown --

MS. BROWN: -- Commissioner Hottinger,

20 Commissioner Massey. As you indicated, we had 12 rules

21 | that are up for review this year. Out of those rules,

22 | six of them we are proposing as no change. 4121-15-02;

23 | 15-04; 15-05; 15-06; 15-07; and 15-08. We also have six

24 that we are proposing for amendment. From the

25 | stakeholders that we have heard from, we received

positive feedback from them and no additional feedback from the stakeholders at this time. Of the rules that are being proposed for amendment, 4121-2-01 includes changing it to gender neutral language and updating the effective amended date of the Ohio Rules of Professional Conduct. 4121-2-02, suspension from practice, includes changes in the language from making it mandatory permissive action, it clarifies the language in the amendment. Also provides gender neutral language and permits Chief Legal Counsel to appoint his staff to make investigations. 4121-3-12 includes correcting terminology and also making the language gender neutral. 4121-15-01 is correcting terminology. 4121-15-03 includes corrections to make it gender neutral, correcting terminology, updating the financial disclosure deadline, and removing duplicative language. And the last one, 4121-15-09, which includes making that language gender neutral.

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MR. HUGHES: Thank you. Are there any questions of our Assistant Chief Legal Counsel regarding the rules that have no change and then the ones she just read that do have change?

I'll first take the no change rules. Is there any changes to anything we've heard today?
